

RIGHT TO REVIEW TEACHER QUALIFICATIONS

As a parent of a student at e-Institute Charter High School you have the right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teachers who instruct your child. Federal law allows you to ask for certain information about your child's classroom teachers and requires us to give you this information in a timely manner if you ask for it. Specifically, you have the right to ask for the following information about each of your child's classroom teachers:

- Level and Subject area of certification., whether the teacher holds emergency or other conditional certificates, the degree(s) the teacher holds and the fields of study.
- The level of the student's achievement on state assessments, and AIMS test scores.
- A notice that the child has been assigned to, or has been taught for 4 or more consecutive weeks by, a teacher who does not meet the definition highly qualified as outlined in NCLB.
- Information about services, as well as their qualifications by teacher's aides and paraprofessionals.
- Information shall be provided in an understandable and uniform format, and to the extent practicable, in a language that parents can understand.
