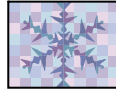

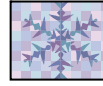

WELCOME



Remember, "Attendance Matters" at e-Institute. Students MUST maintain a 90% attendance rate in order to receive credit for classes taken. We have begun our Block 2 for the 2011-12 school year and we are off to a pretty good start. Parents please remember to call Ms. Rachel @ 623.505.7118 if your son/daughter will be absent. It is imperative that we exceed our last years attendance rate of 88%. The state requires 90% and our goal is 90% or better.

Reminder, keep in mind the numbers 3, 6 & 10. Three times tardy equals one hour absent, student must flex 1 hour absent. At six days absent student's classes may be deleted and a contract will be issued. At 10 days absent, student may be withdrawn from the school. I did not keep my word and delete all of the students that deserved justice for their noncompliance. As a result I have several students whose grades are on hold. This will not be an option block 2. Classes will be deleted upon the 25 hour absent and if their classes were on hold they will lose them as well. Students who are doing well...Keep Up The Great Work!

PRODUCTIVITY

The ultimate goal for ALL students attending e-Institute is to graduate. In order for students to graduate they must not only be present, but also be productive. Please do not begin to get too much into the holiday spirit by "Taking it Easy." Students must still meet their productivity goals daily/weekly. Consistency & effort equates to graduation.



FALL AIMS TEST RESULTS



Students who took the fall AIMS should receive their scores just prior to winter break. If your student has not passed their AIMS and they did not take advantage of the AIMS tutoring which was offered during the regular school day, they will not be able to augment. Reminder letters were sent home in September and students were reminded daily of the importance of attending tutoring.



ACADEMIC PROBATION

Parents, as per the Academic Behavior Contract, all students enrolled into our district must successfully complete a minimum of (4) classes per block. If students fail to meet this expectation, that students and parents signed upon enrollment, students may be required to enroll into our virtual school. This could allow students to devote unlimited time and effort without the constraints of transportation and scheduling. Upon successful completion students may apply to reenroll, but keep in mind enrollment is on a first come first served basis and depends upon space availability. One of the goals for e-Institute is educational success for your child. Working together we can maintain this.
