WELCOME



Remember, "Attendance Matters" at e-Institute. Students MUST maintain a 90% attendance rate in order to receive credit for classes taken. Unfortunately, we had some students lose all classes for violating the attendance policy without flexing their time absent. Other students unfortunately suffered the consequence of receiving an incomplete for their class(es) due to late/missing work. As we draw to the close of Block I, keep in mind students MUST complete a minimum of 4 classes per block, or the student will go on academic probation. Please review the student handbook for further explanation.

Additionally, keep in mind the numbers 3, 6 & 10. Three times tardy equals one hour absent, student must flex 1 hour absent. At six days absent student's classes may be deleted and a contract will be issued. At 10 days absent, student may be withdrawn from the school. Most students have done an exceptional job Block I, Keep up the Great Effort! We are looking forward to an even better Block II and success for each student. Parents, working together we can insure your student's success.



PRODUCTIVITY



For a student to continue his/her enrollment at e-Institute he/she must maintain in three areas: Attendance, Behavior & Academic Achievement/Productivity. We run productivity reports for the computer lab twice weekly. Any student falling below 80% productivity is off track for minimum course completion. Students are required to complete a minimum of 1 lesson per each hour they are in the computer lab daily. This does not mean they complete 1 lesson then take a break. The ultimate goal for ALL students attending e-Institute is to graduate. In order for students to graduate they must not only be present, but also be productive.



FALL AIMS TESTING



We had 95% of our students arrive and complete the fall round of AIMS testing. Great Job! We look forward to all of our students exceeding their previous scores and we are hopeful that many students will finally attain Meets Standards. For those students that still fall short we have interventions in place to prepare for the spring. All we insist is that ALL students put forth their best at ALL times.



ALERT NOW



Parents please check your messages and/or answer your phone when you see the school phone number. We have been sending out Alert Now messages for various reasons. The main recordings are to inform you that your student has been tardy/absent or there are issues in the classrooms, e.g. low productivity, missing work, misbehavior. All calls are not bleak, there are other messages sent out quite frequently for high productivity & kudos. Our purpose is to keep you informed and to be proactive as opposed to prescriptive with regards to your student.
