The night session starts at 4:30 pm and goes until 8:30 pm. Monday through Friday. For students who are currently enrolled in the morning and afternoon sessions, the night session creates an extra opportunity to flex during the evening hours. In fact, many students are already taking advantage of this extra session for making up missing hours.

Like our morning and afternoon sessions, the evening session is monitored and guided by highly qualified teachers. The evening session is currently limited to computer lab instruction. Last year we were able to offer traditional classes in both Language Arts as well as Biology and are planning to do so again this year.

E-Institute offers a customized program to fit the needs of each individual student. We have a wide variety of classes which are both computer based as well as the more traditional direct instruction classes. Courses available include language arts, math, history, science, humanities, government, and sociology.
