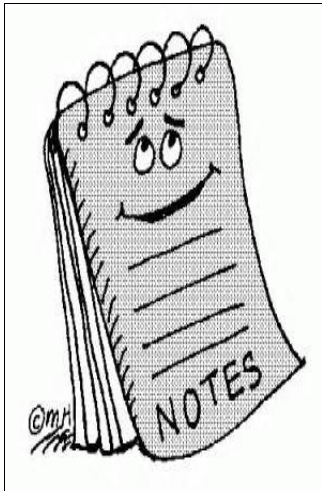


### Express Yourself

### Don't

- Don't worry if you miss something.
- Don't worry if others can't make sense of your notes.
- Don't wait too long to review your notes.
- Don't take notes on everything in the lesson.

### Do's

- Write down the most important things.
- Write question marks where you miss a point.
- Come up with a shorthand system.
- Review your notes regularly.

***Students who take and review their notes can recall up to 80% of a lesson's content.***

## Cell Phones

Cell phone use is the number one reason E-Institute students get themselves in trouble.

- Cell phones may not be on your desk
- Cell phones may not be on your lap.
- If you are listening to music on your phone—DO NOT change the playlist in class.
